DAU Deploys First of Three Digital Literacy Training Tracks

Section 835 of the FY23 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) directed DAU to supplement existing training related to software acquisitions and cybersecurity software/hardware acquisitions to increase digital literacy related to such acquisitions. The **first of three training tracks** in support of the NDAA requirements deployed on August 30, 2024. The **Digital Literacy Basics** curriculum is a **5-course series**. The second track will focus on general civil applications of the technologies, and the third track will focus on DoD applications of the technologies.

Seeking Summer 2025 DCTC Internship Projects

The **Defense Civilian Training Corps (DCTC) Program** is **seeking partner organizations to host DCTC project-based internships in Summer 2025**. These summer internships are a critical component of the DCTC Program. Internship projects enable scholars to apply what they have learned in the DCTC classroom, engage in multidisciplinary teamwork to solve real-world DoD challenges, and gain a valuable security clearance. Internship hosts mentor scholars and help plan their post-graduation job placement. Each DCTC scholar's pathway to employment follows the successful completion of the project-based internship and engagement with partner organizations.

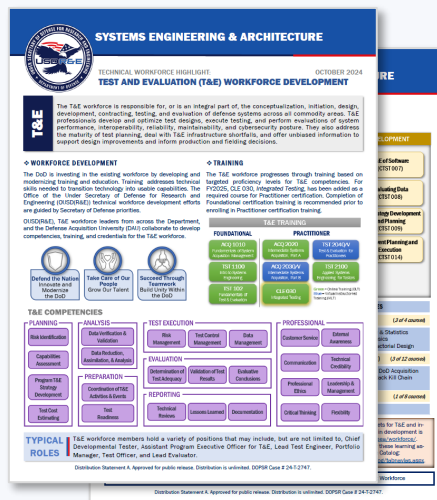
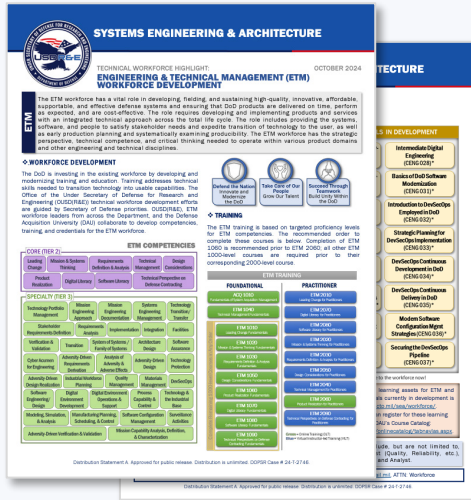
