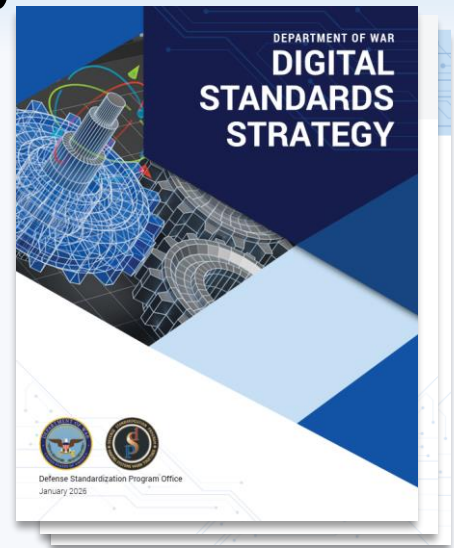

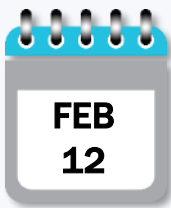
Digital Standards Strategy Released
